Dear St. Francis of Assisi parishioners,

As you know, for ninety days I traveled the Western Hemisphere from Medjugorje to Jerusalem, from Jerusalem to Athens, from Athens to Fatima, from Fatima to Lourdes, and from Lourdes to Meinrad Archabbey, and from Meinrad to home. It was a phenomenal experience in many ways. But one of the most important "takeaways" I got out of my sabbatical was simply this: there really is no place like home!

In all my travels, never once did I see the amount of stewardship involvement like we have at St. Francis. In my time I saw two youth servers, one youth choir, a few lay lectors, and some ushers. But nothing like our parish here at home. The absence of active, visible stewards at liturgies made me yearn for home. Most Masses and parishes were run by religious men and women. Now, to be fair, I traveled mostly to pilgrimage sites, which operate differently than most parishes. At the same time, the absence of lay involvement made me realize how blessed we are as a parish family.

So many people are committed to the mission of the Gospel in so many ways: adult education, bible studies, ACTS retreats, funeral dinners, liturgical ministries, PSR students and volunteers, lawn mowers, ladies' guilds, SFA Grade school, BCCHS high school and so many more! These are all a part of the mission of our parish, all of which is a result of our shared stewardship. Take a moment to consider how many benefits you have received through St. Francis parish: Mass, Adoration, faithful preaching, shared teaching, homebound visits, grief support, updated facilities, and beautiful grounds. Such blessings rise and fall with your faithful stewardship.

It is important, every year, to discern your part to play in the mission of your parish through stewardship. Each one of us must strive desperately to strengthen, or regain, stewardship habits, such as, attending Sunday Mass, giving time in service and prayer, and faithfully tithing! This cannot be an option for us. Please take a moment and ask yourself three questions:

Are you - and your children - going to Mass on Sunday?

Are you finding ways to share your time in service and prayer?

Are you generously fulfilling your pledge to the parish to support its mission?

Please support your parish as your parish supports you. Give of your time, talent, and treasure. This is the only way we can remain faithful to the mission of our parish:

To be united in the Eucharist and formed as instruments of peace through the practice of stewardship in imitation of God's Triune love.

Parishioners in the Diocese of Wichita strive to commit **8 percent** of their gross annual income to the parish and **2 percent** to other charities. If this goal cannot be realized now, we encourage you to begin at some percentage and to prayerfully reexamine it each year.

How to Calculate Your Tithe

If you earn \$4,000 a month, multiply \$4,000 by your desired percent of giving. For example: $44,000 \times 0.08 = 320$ a month to my parish.






